[Hajj Merits & SIGNIFICANCE](#)

Hajj is one of the most integral pillars of Islam upon which Islam has been established. Imam Baqir (as) says "*Islam has been established on the following five elements: prayer, zakāt, fast, hajj and wilāyah*".^[1]

Hajj is of two kind; obligatory and *mustahabb*, it holds immense virtue and abundant reward. Many traditions have been narrated from the Holy Prophet (s.a.w) and the purified *Ahl ul-Bayt* (as) on the merits of hajj. Imam Sadiq (as) says: "*Those who perform Hajj and 'Umrah form the delegation of Allah; if they beg Him, He will grant them; if they call upon Him, He will answer them; if they want to intercede for others, He will accept it; and if they keep quiet, He will speak on their behalf, and they will be compensated with a reward of one million dirhams for the expense of one dirham*".^[2]
