

The Leader's message on Tehran terror attacks - 9 /Jun/ 2017

Following the terrorist incidents on the 12th day of the holy month of Ramadan (June 6) in Tehran, which led to the martyrdom and injury of a number of fasting people, the Leader of Iran's Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei issued a message of condolence.

The full text of the message of the Leader of the Islamic Revolution is as follows:

The definitive result of such (incidents) is nothing but more hatred against the US government and its regional agents such as the Saudi (regime). I also extend (both) my congratulations and condolences to the families of the victims and pray to God Almighty for the recovery of those injured and hurt.
