



The Ghusl of Friday - 6 /Jul/ 2019

The Ghusl of Friday is a highly mustahabb deed. Its primary timeframe extends from daybreak on Friday until the time of the Noon Prayer. If the worshiper does not succeed in performing the Ghusl of Friday in this timeframe, he may perform it between the time of the Noon Prayer on Friday and sunset (ghurūb), but in so doing his intention must, as a matter of mustahabb caution, be simply to perform the deed, without qualifying it as the original deed (adā') or as its compensation (qaḍā'). And if he misses this secondary timeframe, the worshiper may perform the ghusl in question as of the beginning of fajr on Saturday until maghrib on that same day, his intention here being to perform a compensational deed (qaḍā'), not the original deed
