

Observance of the Rules of Correct Recitation in Canonic Prayers - 24 /Nov/ 2019

 $uestion | Is it obligatory to observe the rules of correct Qur'anic recitation (tajw\bar{t}d) \\ --such as madd l\bar{a}zim (required prolongation) and idgh\bar{a}m (contraction) \\ --in performing the canonic prayers?$

answer| It is not obligatory to observe the rules of correct Qur'anic recitation in the canonic prayers. Yet, it is recommended, as a matter of advisory caution (iḥtīyāṭ mustaḥabb), that worshippers implement madd lāzim, refrain from pronouncing the connective sound when pausing (al-waqf bi al-ḥarakah) or from connecting two words while omitting the connective sound between them (al-waṣl bi al-sukūn), and make the pronunciational contraction (idghām) upon encountering the Yarmalūn letters.
