question| Is it permissible to make use of the property, including foodstuffs, of a person who does not pay his khums?

answer| It is permissible to make use of the property, including foodstuffs, of a person who fails to pay khums. Yet, should the appropriate conditions for enjoining good and forbidding evil (al-amr bi al-ma'rūf wa al-nahy 'an al-munkar) be present, one is obligated to remind him of his duty and exhort him to pay khums.
