

Performing Canonic Prayer in Clothes with Human and Animal Designs - 8 /Feb/ 2020

question| We know that it is canonically objectionable to wear clothes that have pictures of people and animals printed on them during canonic prayers (salāt), but what if we wear such clothes underneath other clothes that do not have such designs?

answer| Wearing clothes on which pictures of people and animals are printed when performing a canonic prayer ($\hat{s}al\bar{a}t$) is categorically objectionable (makr $\bar{u}h$), even if they are worn underneath other clothes.
