



To Say Surely/Possibly Missed Prayer behind an Imam - 14 /Mar/ 2022

Question: Sometimes people in masjids offer qadā' prayers in congregation, and the imam of the congregation also offers qadā' prayers which were surely missed or he offers as a caution, is that correct?

Answer: If the Imam says a certainly missed prayer, the believers may offer behind him a surely/possibly missed prayer.

Of course, it should be noted that the connection in congregational prayer is not achieved through someone who says qadā' prayer as caution.

However, if the Imam says qadā' prayer as a caution, we can say prayer behind him only if we say it as a caution and the reason for saying it as caution is the same as that of imam.
