



Leader's Message of Condolence on Tragic Pakistan Earthquake - 10 /Oct/ 2005

October 10, 2005

The Leader of the Islamic Republic of Iran Ayatollah Sayyid Ali Khamenei, in a message issued on October 10, 2005, expressed his condolence over the tragic incident of the devastating earthquake in Pakistan which left tens of thousands of casualties. In his message, the Leader also called on the Iranian government to extend necessary relief aid to the Pakistani people in the quake-stricken regions. The text of the message is as follows:...

The Iranian nation and government share the grief of their Pakistani brethren and consider it their duty to extend whatever assistance that may alleviate the suffering of those affected by the earthquake. I expect this duty to be carried out without negligence.

I pray to Almighty Allah to bestow mercy and remission on those who have perished in the earthquake and grant their bereaved families fortitude and forbearance.
