## **IR Leader: All parties refrain from controversy - 4 /Jul/ 2011**

Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Sayyed Ali Khamenei on Monday called on rival parties to refrain from controversy.

Ayatollah Khamenei said in a meeting with commanders of the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps that the body is not merely for safeguarding the Islamic Revolution.
